

**PERIPHERAL NERVE SOCIETY'S
INFLAMMATORY NEUROPATHY CONSORTIUM
CALL FOR NOMINATIONS PROCESS**

ARTICLE II: INC Board

Section 2: *Number and Composition of the Board:* The Board shall be composed of no more than sixteen (16) voting board members, including twelve (12) elected board members and up to four (4) Officers of the Consortium – the Chair, the Co-Chair, the Immediate Past Chair, and Secretary. The Board shall appoint nonvoting Board members as it desires.

Section 3: *Term and Election of the Board:* The Chair, Immediate Past Chair, and the Co-Chair, serve a term of two (2) years and the Secretary will serve for a four (4) year term. Officers of the Consortium are selected by a majority vote of the INC Board.

ARTICLE III. Nominations

The Inflammatory Neuropathy Consortium (INC) accepts nominations for four open at-large seats (1/3 of their Board Members) on the Board of Directors for a four year term. Below is the process for identifying and electing candidates of open at-large director seats.

1. Send Call for Nominations to membership.
2. Nominees must be nominated by a PNS member in good standing.
3. The nominee must be a member of PNS in good standing.
4. The Executive Office will contact the nominees to verify that individuals accept the nomination.
5. Each nominee will prepare a brief statement regarding their qualification and positions.
6. INC Membership will vote.
7. The top two nominees voted by membership will automatically be chosen to sit on the INC Board.
8. The other two nominees will be vetted and selected by the INC Board of Directors.
9. The new directors will be announced to membership via e-mail.
