About us and MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships

The [μNEURO Research Centre of Excellence](#) at the [University of Antwerp](#) strives to conduct **interdisciplinary, top-level translational neuroscience research on a cell-to-organism wide scale**. Our consortium is a unique combination of experts in fundamental, preclinical and clinical research on neurological diseases and quantitative multimodal ((pre)clinical) imaging and analysis experts.

The Horizon Europe [MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships](#) (MSCA PF) are postdoctoral fellowships for experienced researchers looking to give their career a boost by working abroad. The grant has a duration of 12-24 months (European Fellowships) or 24-36 months (Global Fellowships).

We welcome **research topics in the field of neurosciences and/or neuro-imaging** that align with at least one of the [core objectives of μNEURO](#). Your proposal will be matched with the expertise of one of the [μNEURO professors](#) (e.g. the team of Prof. Vincent Timmerman is active in the PNS/CMT research field) as your future supervisor.

- A stimulating, interdisciplinary environment for top-level neuroscience research, including cutting-edge imaging infrastructure (MRI, PET, CT, microscopy, ...).
- Support and guidance for the preparation of your MSCA PF proposal from your future supervisor and the μNEURO research manager.
- An informative MSCA-PF starter package, a dedicated training session, advise on institutional aspects and horizontal issues, and administrative support from the Grants Office of the University of Antwerp.
- Advise and comprehensive support from the International Staff Office of the University of Antwerp for incoming international researchers.

Your Profile

Only candidates that meet the **eligibility and evaluation criteria for an MSCA PF** can apply:

- You obtained a PhD degree (at the latest by the time of the MSCA PF call deadline).
- You have no more than 8 years of research experience after obtaining your PhD (excluding experience outside research and career breaks).
- You did not reside or work in Belgium for more than 12 months during the 36 months before the call deadline (12 October 2021, tbc).
