CMTR Constitution: Board Composition

The CMTR will have an elected board comprising a Chair, a Vice-Chair, a Secretary, and six Ordinary Members.

The Chair of the CMTR will have a place on the PNS Board.

The Chair and Vice-Chair will be elected for a two-year non-renewable term in the same position.

After two years, the Vice-Chair will assume the Chair position without further election. After the end of the term, the Chair will have a position in the CMTR Board as Past-Chair for two years.

Three new Board Ordinary Members will be elected every two years, for a four-year term.

Board Ordinary Members are allowed to stand for two consecutive terms but to stand for further years they need a break of at minimum two years.

The Secretary is elected for a two years term which is renewable just once.

Nominations

The Charcot Marie Tooth & Related Neuropathies Consortium accepts nominations for Board Members.

Below is the process for identifying and electing Board candidates.

1. Send call for Nominations to membership.
2. Nominees must be nominated by a PNS member.
3. The nominee must be a member of the PNS.
4. The Executive Office will contact the nominees to verify that individuals accept the nomination.
5. Each nominee will prepare a brief statement regarding their qualification and positions.
6. CMTR Membership will vote.
7. A Chair, a vice-Chair, a Secretary-Treasurer and 3 out of the 6 Ordinary Members for a four-year term will be elected.
8. The top three candidates will automatically serve on the CMTR Board. The new directors will be announced to membership via e-mail.
9. The Call for Nominations will occur every other year.
10. The Officers will serve 2 year terms, while the Board Members will serve a term of 4 years after the first round (where half of them served for 2 years to ensure partial rotation).
